DATABASE UPDATE

To ensure efficient communication, **please make sure to respond to National Network text messages and phone calls.** Keeping our database accurate and up to date allows us to better serve and support your organization.

MOON SIGHTING & EID AL-FITR

The sighting of the new crescent moon (hilal) is crucial in determining the day of Eid al-Fitr. The discussion focused on proper practices, rulings, and community responsibilities:

- **Method of Sighting:** Depending on the scholar you follow, the hilal must be sighted either with the naked eye or using optical aids. Weather conditions and visibility are critical factors in confirming the sighting.
- **Use of Local or Distant Sightings:** Whether a sighting in one location (e.g., Dearborn, Michigan) applies to another (e.g., New York) depends on the scholar's ruling. Opinions differ, with common views being multiple horizons, shared horizons, or shared nights.
- **Handling Conflicting Reports:** Discrepancies may arise. Carefully examine the sources and focus on sharing accurate information, not issuing rulings.
- **Community Member Role:**
 - If you can go out and witness the crescent moon firsthand, be sure to take another witness with you, so if it is sighted there is a great sense of consensus.
 - Consult trusted scholars if conflicting information arises.
 - Respect diversity and maintain unity, even if communities celebrate on different days.
