



D.R.I.V.E Rules and Expectations

The following are rules and expectations for all participants and staff. All attendees are expected to observe these rules and expectations.

- Keep track of your belongings (clothing, electronics, toiletries, money, etc.). Mark your name on all of your personal items.
- Leave valuables at home.
- Respect all campers and show kindness.
- No use of foul language at any time.
- Observe modest clothing. Clothing with suggestive logos or artwork are not appropriate. If you choose to wear such clothing, you will be asked to change. Modesty is very important for both males and females.
- Boys: No cut off shirts or short/tight clothing.
- Girls: Modesty must be observed at all times in common areas. Long (mid-thigh or longer) loose tops and pants/skirts. NO skinny jeans or leggings.
- Pack lightly. The more you bring, the more you have to carry. The focus of the camp is on spiritual and personal growth. Do not bring items that may cause distractions.
- No tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are permitted on the premises. If you are caught with any of these items, you will be sent home immediately at your expense.
- All prescribed medication should be labeled and turned in to the staff medical coordinator for administration.
- Once you have arrived at the campground, you are not allowed to leave the campsite until completion of camp.
- Safety rules must be observed at all times.
- Report any issues to staff members, do not take matters into your own hands.
- We need to respect the camp and each other by keeping the camp clean.
- Practice moderation and do not be wasteful during mealtimes. This includes drinking water.
- Clean up after yourself in the dining hall. All trash must be placed in trash bins at all times.
- Chairs are not to be moved from the dining area.
- Keep showers to a minimum in order to make time for everyone.
- Attendance is mandatory for all activities including educational programs, prayers, and activities.
- You must be on time to all camp functions.
- Enter the prayer hall through the designated entrances. Place shoes on rack before entering the prayer hall.
- Use of the lake, sports, and activities will be restricted to specified times with a lifeguard or staff member present. Use of these activities during other times is strictly forbidden.
- Put all activity equipment back where you found it after using them. Any damage to equipment will result in replacement charges.
- "Lights out" is strictly enforced to make sure we all get the rest needed for the next day.
- At ALL times, females are not allowed in the male wing, and males are not allowed in the female wing.

These expectations are in place to facilitate the best weekend possible at the DRIVE Retreat. If at any time these expectations are not met, we hold discretion to impose consequences.
